

If you would like to bring your palms from last year — we have a collection box set up in the narthex.






Sowing Peace: Digging into Lenten Themes of Lament, Repent & Forgive





Litany for Lent (excerpt)

- Jesus crucified, sanctuary of justice and love, full of goodness, source of all faithfulness, worthy of all praise, -We worship you.
- Jesus crucified, king and master of every heart, in whom are all treasures of wisdom and understanding; In whom dwells the fullness of the godhead; and in whom the father is well pleased; -We worship you.
- Christ, from your fullness we have received all things: you are our eternal hope, full of patience and mercy, and generous to all who call upon you; Intercede for us.
- Christ, spring of life and holiness, you atone for our sins, bore our injuries and were bruised for our offenses; -Intercede for us. -Intercede for us.
- Christ, obedient unto death, wounded for our sins, source of all consolation, our life and our resurrection, our peace and our reconciliation; -Intercede for us.
- Christ, victim of our sin, salvation of all who trust in you, hope of all who die in you, joy of all the Saints, -Intercede for us.
